Question 2: Is it worth it?

We often wonder what it will cost us to followJesus. We may even ask, "Is it really worth it?" What will it cost us at work, in our relationships, in our finances? But what if Jesus wants more for us if we will just trust him and go "all-in"?

Discussion Questions

- 1. Can you think of a time when following Jesus cost you something? What exactly did it cost you (e.g., popularity, loss of job, loss of friendship, etc.)?
- 2. What could it cost you if you decided to not follow Jesus?
- 3. How confident are you that commands and directives from Jesus are meant to give you life?
- 4. Matthew 16:25 says, "For whoever wants to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for me will find it."
 - When you hear that Jesus wants something for you rather than from you, how does it make you feel? What thoughts come to mind?
 - · What does it look like to go "all-in" with Jesus?
- 5. What is the one thing you need to lose in order to have a more meaningful life with Jesus?

Going "All-In"

This can sound intimidating, but God is a good father who sent his Son to give us a fully abundant life. Consider sharing your answer to the last question with your group, and then follow up with your group over the next few days or weeks. In order to get the life Jesus wants to give you, you have to let go of the one you are currently holding onto.
